# I. KINDER M8 PARENT PORTAL

#### 1.1 HOME PAGE

Login to the Home Page using your Email and Password.




You will see the Daily Summary, News Feed and Calendar.






Click on the icon on the top right corner of the page to view the latest notifications.

Click on the menu tab shown as 3 bars, on the top left corner of the screen to navigate your system.




Here, you can navigate to a Child Profile, view the Newsletters, General Forms and Policies by clicking on the relevant tab on the menu.

Click on Newsletter/General Forms/Policies to Preview or Download them.







#### 1.1.1 MEDICATIONS


You can now request medication to be administered at the centre. You can include the date, time, and dosage to be administered.

**Prescribed Medication:** You can request to administer/apply medications and creams that are prescribed by your doctor using the parent portal.


**Non-Prescribed Medication**: Parents can also request to administer/apply medications and creams that are that are not prescribed by the doctor, using the parent portal.




Click on "+ Add Medications" to add a Medication for your child and select the Medication type (Prescribed/Non-Prescribed).




Once you click the Prescribed Medication/Non Presibed Medication, You will see the form to be filled .








When the completed medication form has been aved, the details will be shown under the medication list view.







Once the request has been uploaded it has to be acknowledged and approved by the administrator.

Once approved, the medication status will be changed and you will not be able to edit or delete.




In the medication list you can view the medications created by you as well as by the administrator.




To view the medication details, click on the view icon











#### 1.2 THE NEWS FEED

The News Feed on the Home Page is where you can see all updates made by your child's centre including special moments during the day, upcoming events and more. It works just like Facebook where you can like or comment on posts.

If you or your children are tagged in a post, it will appear only on your feed. You are then able to like or comment on that post.



#### 1.3 SENDING AND RECEIVING MESSAGES

Select the icon on your Home Page in the top right corner, to go to your personal inbox. You can view messages that have been sent to you here.


Click on relevant Compose to write a new message. You can email a group or specific people by selecting the filters.






#### 1.4 VIEWING AND RESPONDING TO NOTES

Click on the icon on the top right of the page and select a child to view a NOTE.






To respond or make a new NOTE, click on the comment box at the bottom and click



#### 1.5 CHANGING YOUR SETTINGS

- Click on your User Name and select Settings to change your personal settings.
- You can change your personal information, image or password on this page.
- If you have forgotten your password, you can email the centre and they will be able to send you a link to reset it.






**Tip:** You only need to create one Parent account for each family – multiple children can be added to the same Parent. If you wish, you can share their login details with extended family members. However, as the parent, you have to take full responsibility when sharing these details. You can also link a child to two separate accounts if necessary, such as if parents are separated or for grandparents. If you create two accounts, then we need a signed consent form from the family.



#### 1.6 CALENDAR

Here you can view the "Events" and "Activities" details which are created by the centre. To see the particular activities of your child, just go to the Activities Tab, and click on your child.







## II. KINDER M8 MOBILE APP

#### 2.1 SIGN UP & LOGIN


- The Kinder m8 app may be downloaded from Google Play Store for Android or App Store for Apple

- Install the app on your device. Once it is installed, you can login with your Email and password














#### 2.3 MENU

Click and select the name of the child profile you want to view. You will then see the option to view the child's Daily Journal, Observations, Medications, Daily Chart, Learning story and Photos.






#### 2.4.1 MEDICATION

**Non-Prescribed Medication**: Parents can request to administer/apply medications and creams that are not prescribed by the doctor.









